**NBC4 Chief Meteorologist Doug Kammerer is Mary's Center's 2012 Honorary Spokesperson**

Kammerer's first contact with Mary's Center was his invitation to serve as Master of Ceremonies of the Center's annual Gala *Noche Tropical* in October 2011.

"I feel a deep connection to Mary's Center's work," said Kammerer. "After their Gala I wanted to do more and spoke with the team about supporting the Center through my work at NBC4 to broaden awareness of the wonderful services they provide to meet the health, education and social needs of vulnerable families in the region."

Doug Kammerer joined NBC4 in August 2010 and forecasts the weather weekdays on News4 at 5:00 pm, 6:00 pm and 11pm.

"You just have to watch him in the news to understand that he is more than a weather expert – he is a truly caring individual and we are so thankful that he has chosen to use his platform to support Mary's Center's work in our community," said Rebecca Diamond, Chief Development Officer at Mary's Center. "The Mary's Center team is very excited about Doug joining us as Spokesperson."

Kammerer and Mary's Center have planned multiple events for 2012 that will involve Mr. Kammerer's participation as Spokesperson.
