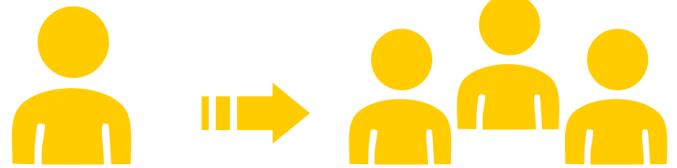

## Our outcomes speak to the effectiveness of our overlapping programs:

- ◆ 60% of our pregnant participants enrolled for prenatal care in 1st trimester.
- ◆ 94% of our babies are born at a healthy birth weight (5.5 lbs).
- ◆ 72% of our children receive the recommended childhood immunizations by age 2.
- ◆ 85% of adults who learn English in our family literacy program participate in neighborhood, school, community and political advocacy work.
- ◆ 87% of our family literacy program participants with an employment goal obtained or retained employment.
- ◆ 85% of parents who complete the family literacy program read with their children.
- ◆ 99% of our Teen Program participants avoid pregnancy and graduate from high school.
