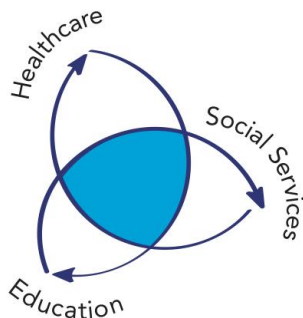
## AN INNOVATIVE APPROACH TO CARE

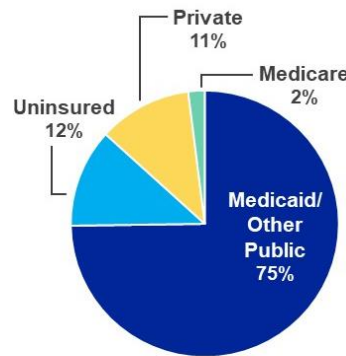

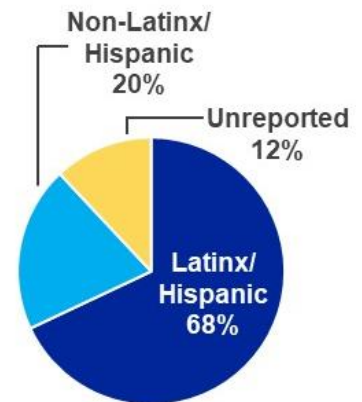
**GENDER**



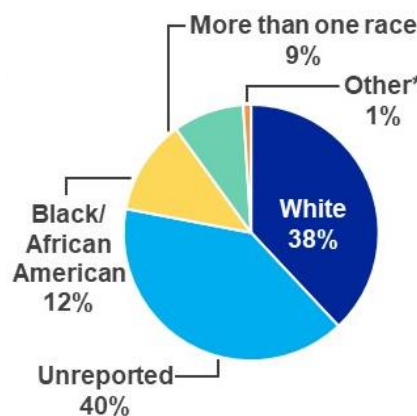
**AGE**
